S.R.O.No.516/2003.—In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Services Act, 1963 (19 of 1968), the Government of Kerala hereby make the following Special Rules for the Kerala State Central Library Service, namely:—

RULES

- 1. Short title and commencements.—(I) These rules may be called the Kerala State Central Library Service Rules, 2003.
 - '(2) They shall come into force at once.
- 2. Constitution.—The Service shall consist of the following categories of officers, namely:—

Category 1 State Librarian

Category 2 Deputy State Librarian

Category 3 Librarian Grade I

3. Appointment to the various categories of posts mentioned in column (1) of the Table below shall be made by the method specified in column (2) thereof:—

- 4. Appointing Authority.—The appointing authority in respect of all the categories in the service shall be the Government.
- 5. Qualification regarding age.—No person shall be eligible for appointment by direct recruitment, if he has not completed 18 years of age. For category I (State Librarian) the maximum age limit will be 45 years. For Category II (Deputy State Librarian) the maximum age limit will be 40 years. For category III (Librarian Grade I) the maximum age limit will be 35 years as on the 1st day of January of the year in which applications are invited with usual relaxation in case of SC/ST and other backward classes.
- 6. Other Qualifications.—No person shall be eligible for appointment to any of the categories specified in column (i) by the method specified in column (2) of the Table below, unless he possesses the qualifications prescribed in the corresponding entry in column (3) thereof:—

Deputy (a) By promotion State Librarian Degree in any subject and Masters Degree in Library & Information Science.

By direct recruitment.

- (i) Degree in any subject one acquired after a regular course of study from a recognised University and Masters Degree in Library & Information Science acquired after a regular course of study from a recognised University.
- (ii) Five years experience as Librarian in an Established Library.

Librarian (a) By transfer Grade I

Bachelors Degree in any subject and Masters Degree in Library & Information Science.

(b) By direct recruitment.

- (i) Degree in any subject one acquired after a regular course of study from a recognised University and Masters Degree in Library & Information Science acquired after a regular course of study from recognised University.
- (ii) Three years experience as Librarian in an Established Library.

Note:—Appointment to Categories of State Librarian Deputy State Librarian and Librarian Grade I shall be made from a select list.

Explanation :- The term 'Established Library' means,

(i) any Library attached to a Government Department or Government Institution

-OR

- (ii) any Library of a University, Court of Commission; OR
- (iii) any Library attached to a body or institution or undertaking under the control of the Government.

- 7. Reservation of appointment.—General Rules 14 to 17 in part II de Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules 1958 shall apply to appointments by direct recruitment.
- 8. Probation.—Any person appointed to any of the category shall, from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation,—
 - (i) if appointed by direct recruitment or by transfer from any other service for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years; and
 - (ii) if appointed by promotian, for a total period of one year on duty within a continuous period of two years.
- 9. Test.—Every person appointed to any of the categories shall within the period of probation pass the Account Test (Lower) or Executive Officers Test conducted by the Kerala Public Service Commission.

The Special Rules for the posts in the Public Library (State Central Library) have not been issued so far, Government now propose to issue Special Rules for the posts by prescribing qualifications, method of appointment etc.
